

#### SUNDAY OBLIGATION

The Bishops of Scotland have reinstated the Sunday obligation, after postponing it before Christmas due to the Omicron variant. Catholics in Scotland will be expected to attend Sunday Mass from the 6th March.

In a statement from the Bishops' Conference, Bishop Hugh Gilbert said: "Given the easing of restrictions in every other walk of life, the Church looks forward to welcoming Catholics back to Holy Mass."

The Sunday obligation does not apply to those 'who are sick and their carers or to those aware of their greater vulnerability to the virus.'
