GROUNDWORKS UPDATE

We are thrilled to be able to tell you that our planning application to the local council, for the proposed groundworks outside the church, has been approved!!! Our application will now proceed to the Fabric and Planning Committee of Motherwell Diocese for their approval, which we hope to hear about in May.

We are setting a realistic start date for the proposed works for the beginning of 2023, which takes into account waiting for approval, finding a contractor, delays in obtaining building materials and of course raising the funds to carry out the works. We have applied for a number of grants which we are waiting to hear about. In terms of our own fundraising efforts we have been amazed at how much we have raised, as a parish, in such a short space of time. Thank you to everyone who has contributed. Our Building Fund Account currently holds £81,000! As fantastic as this is, we are still a long way short of the amount we need to complete the works. The images below show how the church and grounds will look once they are completed and we hope you agree the result will be stunning. As our church is a Grade A listed building the groundworks need to reflect this in terms of the design, quality of materials and the finish. We are hopeful that through our fundraising efforts and the grants we have applied for that we will be in a position to carry out the works without the need of a loan. The Kiltwalk, is, therefore, a huge opportunity for us to raise the majority of the funds we need, see below.
