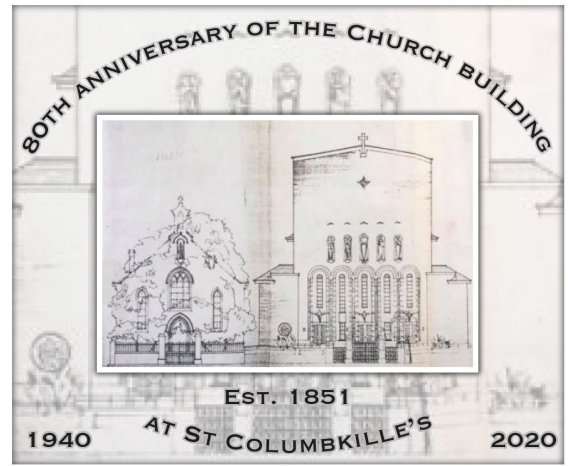

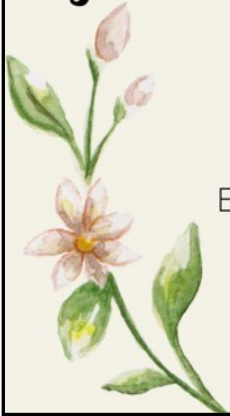
### LEGION OF MARY
