#### EPIPHANY BLESSING OF HOMES

The Epiphany blessing of chalk and homes is a centuries old tradition that not only places God at the entrance of your home but is also a powerful blessing that places your entire family under His protection. Traditionally a priest will bless the chalk, which is distributed after Mass. The faithful can then use the chalk to bless their home. It is a beautiful blessing, that brings many graces upon those who practice it in faith, and is a powerful protection against spiritual enemies.

# The Blessing (Shortened version)

Let us pray. Bless, O Lord God almighty, this home, that in it there may be health, purity, the strength of victory, humility, goodness and mercy, the fulfilment of Thy law, the thanksgiving to God the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. And may this blessing remain upon this home and upon all who dwell herein. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

After the blessing, walk through the house and bless each room by sprinkling with Holy Water. Take the blessed chalk and first write the initials of the three Wise Men, connected with Crosses, over the inside of your front door (on the lintel, if possible). Then write the year, breaking up the numbers and the year so that they fall on both sides of the initials **e.g. 20 C+M+B 25**. #### 300 CLUB 2025


