

LENT 2025

Ash Wednesday is 5th March this year and marks the beginning of the penitential season of Lent. Holy Mass and the distribution of ashes will be at 7am, 10am, 1pm and 7pm. It is a day of fasting and abstinence. **Fasting** is required of adult Catholics between 18 and 59yrs old. You are permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. **Abstinence** (refraining from the consumption of meat) is obliged for Catholics 14yrs and older.

In addition to our normal Mass schedule, during Lent Mass will be celebrated: 7am on Mondays, 7pm on Thursdays and a special 8.15am Mass during term time on Fridays, especially for school children (tea and toast after Mass). Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will take place on Thursdays 9.30am ~ 7pm. Full timetable and sign up sheets for Guardians of the Blessed Sacrament will be available soon.
